**Title:** Healing: Pray, Believe and Receive      5-17-26

**Text:** **Mark 5:24-34** KJV

And Jesus went with him; and much people followed him, and thronged him. [25] And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, [26] And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, [27] When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and **touched** his **garment**. [28] For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole. [29] And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague. [30] And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that **virtue** had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes? [31] And his disciples said unto him, Thou seest the multitude thronging thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me? [32] And he looked round about to see her that had done this thing. [33] But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the truth. [34] And he said unto her, Daughter, **thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.**

Virtue: **Gr.** = dunamis, doo'-nam-is; force, miraculous power, ability, abundance, might, power, strength, violence, might (wonderful) work. ( Refer to **Acts 1:8** )

Garment: **commentary:** The Jewish robe had tassels that represented the Word of God. By touching Jesus tassel, she attached herself to the Word of healing. ( Refer to **Is. 53: 4-5** )

**Introduction:** The woman with the issue of blood did 3 things in order to receive her healing. She *prayed, believed,* and then *received.* She spoke of her confidence to be healed, she saw herself as healed, and she received her healing.

I. **Pray** ( Say you believe you are healed ) **I Peter 2:24**

A. **V. 27- 28:** When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment. [28] For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.

Amplified: She had heard the reports concerning Jesus, and she came up behind Him in the throng and touched His garment, For she kept saying, If I only touch His garments, I shall be restored to health.

touch: **Gr.** = to attach oneself to

B. Faith comes by hearing: **Rom. 10:17** So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

C. Power of the tongue: **Proverbs 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

II. **Believe:** ( See yourself as healed )

A. **Mark 11:24** Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe ( see ) that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

B.. **Mark 9:23** Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

III. **Receive** ( Act like you would if you had your healing, because by faith, you do. )

A. Have a vision of your healing: **Habakkuk 2:2-3** And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. [3] For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

vision: **Heb.** = a mental sight

B. Keep the “switch of faith” turned on. Cast down thoughts of doubt. **I John 5:14-15** And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: [15] And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

Amplified: And this is the confidence (the assurance, the privilege of boldness) which we have in Him: [we are sure] that if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan), He listens to and hears us. And if (since) we [positively] know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted us as our present possessions] the requests made of Him.

**Conclusion:** The story of the woman being healed from her issue of blood reminds us that we can either *pray, believe and receive, or doubt, pout and do without.*
