Title: How to Use Faith

6-14-26

Text: **Mark 11:24**

I. We all start out with the same measure of faith: Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure (portion) of faith.

a. Our faith can grow: **Romans 10:17** So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

(Faith for healing comes by hearing and hearing the Word on healing.)

(Faith for prosperity comes by hearing and hearing the Word on prosperity.)

II. We have the faith of God: Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

III. We live by faith: Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.

a. Abraham was the first to believe God: **James 2:23** And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

(We are of the seed of Abraham)

IV. We use our faith to believe that Jesus exists: **Heb 11:6** But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

(Believing is seeing)

V. We use our faith for things we need or desire: **Mark 11:24** Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Mk 11:24 (**Amplified**) For this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe (trust and be confident) that it is granted to you, and you will [get it].

VI. Faith is the substance and evidence of what we believe we have received: **Heb 11:1** Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

VII. Faith speaks: **Mark 11:22-23** And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he
