Title: Our Daily Walk In The Kingdom

Text: **Col. 1:12-13** Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: [13] Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the **kingdom** of his dear Son:

Intro: Our daily walk in the Kingdom begins with getting good sleep. Next, we rise up and get ready for the day. It is important to keep our eyes on what God has called us to do during the day. Better is our day when we begin with praise. There will be spiritual battles that we win by using our spiritual weapons. We fight a good fight because we have already won In Christ.

Kingdom: **Gr. = basileia, bas-il-i'-ah;** a realm where one reigns as a king.

I. Sleep ([References](#))

Psalms 4:8 I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, Lord, only makest me dwell in safety.

Proverbs 3:24 When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.

II. Rise Up

A. Put on the new man In Christ: **Ephes. 4:24** And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

1. Renew our mind: **Romans 12:2** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

2. Washing: **Ephes. 5:26** That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, (This is also called sanctification)

3. Praise: (praise is mentioned 216 x Bible)

2 Chron. 7:6 And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of musick of the Lord, which David the king had made to **praise** the

Lord, because his mercy endureth for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood.

Psalm 100:4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with **praise**: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.

praise: **Heb.** = yadah, yaw-daw'; . hold out the hand; physically to throw (a stone, an arrow) at or away; especially to revere or worship (with extended hands);

III. Walk

Galatians 5:25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also **walk** in the Spirit.

walk: **Gr.** = stoicheo, stoy-kheh'-o; to march in (military) rank (keep step), walk (orderly).

2 Cor. 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh:

1. Good Fight: **1 Tim. 6:12** Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

2 Tim. 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have **kept** the faith:

kept: **Gr.** = keep your eyes on the prize.

2. Using the Sword of the Spirit: **2 Cor. 10:4-5** (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) [5] Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

3. Guarding our thought life: **Philip. 4:8** Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

Conclusion: We begin our daily walk in the Kingdom by getting restful sleep. After preparing for his day, we walk and win spiritual battles using our spiritual weapons. Better is our day when we begin with praise.
