John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

John 14:17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

Jn 14:26-27 Amplified: But the **Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, Standby)**, the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything I have told you.

Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give and bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]

(7) Things the Holy Spirit does for us. From **John 14:26**

1. Comforter: He surrounds us and comforts us like a blanket

2. Counselor: **Proverbs 3:5-6** Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. [6] In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

3. Helper: **Isaiah 41:10** Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

help: **Heb.** = to surround, protect or aid.

4. Intercessor: **Romans 8:26** Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. (He communicates to the Father what we need.)

5. Advocate: One who assists, defends, or pleads for another. A lawyer... defends us when we have been accused by the enemy.

Rev. 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

6. Strengtheners: **Ephes. 3:16** That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

might: **Gr.** = **dunamis**, **doo'-nam-is**; miraculous power, ability, abundance, worker of miracles strength, wonderful work.

7. Standby: **Ephes. 3:20** Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

standby: **verb** (3)

1. To wait in expectation of some event; to make ready. Example: "Please stand by for more instructions."

2. To remain loyal or faithful to.

3. To support; to continue to support despite things being bad.
